

ITA HIGH SCHOOL STANDARD DIPLOMA

REQUIREMENTS

*All students must fulfill the requirement of minimum of 100 hours of community service to qualify for the Bright Futures Academic Excellence Scholarship.

The Standard Diploma is aligned with the Florida Department of Education requirements for graduation.

World language (a foreign language besides Lashon Kodesh) is not required for this program although it is strongly recommended if a student plans to attend college.

- 1. Requires a minimum of 25.5 credits of secular subjects
- 2. 9 to 11 credits of Judaics subjects
- 3. Requires no less than 2.5 GPA

REQUIREMENTS

It is recommended for the student who desires a college education in preparation for a professional career.

This type of diploma is also suitable for students planning to attend a university as Pre-Law majors.

ITA College Preparatory Diploma is aligned with the Florida Department of Education requirements for graduation.

World language (a foreign language besides Lashon Kodesh) is not required for this program although it is strongly recommended if the student plans to attend college.

- 1. Requires 30.5 credits, 4 of which must be Honors, Dual Enrollment or Advanced Placement.
- 2. Requires a min. 3.0 GPA.
- 3. Requires a min. score of 1210 on SAT or 25 on the ACT (2022-23 graduates).
